Sciences (USUHS) for a 24 month period via forthcoming Permanent Change of
Station (PCS) orders to USUHS.
4. All school expenses (i.e., books, tuition, labs, etc.) will be paid by USUHS
for the entire length of the course.
5. EMDP2 participants who complete program requirements but fail to obtain
acceptance to a medical school, or who are disenrolled from the program, will be
reassigned in their Primary MOS at the discretion of HQMC.
