LCME Visit Scheduled from 25-28 Oct 2015

HISTORICAL INFORMATION:

- The Charter Class was admitted to the School of Medicine (SOM) in 1976 and included just 32 students;
- The SOM Class of '19 includes 171 new students;
- The SOM has graduated more than 5,000 physicians;
- The Class of '15 was the first to graduate under the auspices of the new Molecules to Military Medicine (M2MM) curriculum.

LCME STANDARD #1: MISSION, PLANNING, ORGANIZATION & INTEGRITY

- ◆ The SOM's Vision Statement: *"We are America's medical school, recognized as the leader in the education of physicians and scientists to care for those in harm's way in a rapidly evolving global frontier."*

LCME STANDARD #3: ACADEMIC & LEARNING ENVIRONMENTS

- ◇ Enhancing diversity throughout the University is a cardinal goal. To support this effort, the SOM offers three distinct "Pipeline Programs." They are the:
 - ⇒ Enlisted to Medical Degree Preparatory Program (EMDP2)
 - * 24 month program for currently serving, military enlisted personnel
 - * 1st group of 5 AF & 5 Army members started in Fall, 2014

 - ⇒ Science, Service, Medicine Mentoring (S2M2)
 - * Week-long program for High School students

 - ⇒ USU Summer Research Training Program (USRTP)
 - * 9 week program, designed for High School students, in Summer prior to start of senior year
 - * Students work on a project with a designated faculty mentor
