LCME STANDARD #10: MEDICAL STUDENT SELECTION, ASSIGNMENT AND PROGRESS

“A medical school establishes and publishes admissions requirements for potential applicants...and uses effective policies and procedures for medical student selection, enrollment, and assignment.”

LCME STANDARD #12: MEDICAL STUDENT HEALTH SERVICES, PERSONAL COUNSELING, FINANCIAL AID SERVICES

“A medical school provides effective student services to all medical students to assist them in achieving the program’s goals for its students. All medical students have the same rights and receive comparable services.”

THESE STANDARDS ADDRESS A NUMBER OF KEY AREAS WHICH INCLUDE:

- ◆ *Ensuring that the list of prerequisites are regularly reviewed;*
- ◆ *Reviewing the roles, responsibilities and procedures associated with the SOM’s Admissions Committee;*
- ◆ *Reviewing the methods used by the Admissions Committee in order to identify prospective matriculants to the SOM;*
- ◆ *Analyzing the policies and procedures governing the Student Promotions Committee, and the corresponding assessment, advancement, and graduation of medical students;*



- ◆ *Ensuring that students have access to financial aid and debt management related services and/or counseling.*
 ⇒ *For even though the School of Medicine is a tuition free institution, some students may have acquired significant personal or undergraduate debt;*



- ◆ *Determining whether effective systems are in place to assist students in adjusting to the physical and emotional demands of medical school;*
- ◆ *Ensuring that students have ready access to needed medical services and that student privacy and confidentiality are appropriately preserved.*
