### LCME Visit Scheduled from 25-28 Oct 2015

#### LCME STANDARD #5: EDUCATIONAL RESOURCES AND INFRASTRUCTURE

*“A medical school has sufficient personnel, financial resources, physical facilities, equipment, and clinical, instructional, informational, technological, and other resources readily available and accessible across all locations to meet its needs and to achieve its goals.”*

#### THIS STANDARD ADDRESSES A NUMBER OF KEY AREAS WHICH INCLUDE:

- \* A review of the University’s annual budget, operating margin and financial reserves;
- \* Consideration of the ways in which financial resources are managed;
- \* The use and availability of fiscal resources to support medical education (funding, faculty, infrastructure, etc.);
- \* The availability of sufficient space and equipment needed to support the University’s educational, clinical, and research related missions. Included is a consideration of any new or anticipated changes that are expected to take place within the next 3 years (ex: emerging plans for Building F);
- \* Ensuring that School of Medicine students have the ability to work with and learn from, an appropriate number and type of patients in both the ambulatory and inpatient settings. This includes a consideration of overall acuity, case mix, age, gender, etc.;
- \* A review of all the security, safety and disaster preparedness policies and procedures that apply to the USU campus (both during and outside of standard duty hours), as well as those that pertain to each of the clinical teaching sites utilized by rotating students;
- \* This standard also incorporates a review of library (LRC) related resources, technology (IT) related resources and support, the availability of wireless Internet connectivity, as well as a review of the number and type of student lounge and/or study spaces.
