**Mark E. Peterson, JD, LL.M.**

Mark Peterson is the Acting General Counsel at the Uniformed Services University of the Health Sciences (USUHS), in Bethesda, MD. Mr. Peterson graduated with a Juris Doctor (J.D.) from the J. Reuben Clark Law School, Brigham Young University, in 1992, and received a Masters in Law (LL.M.) in Air and Space Law from McGill University, Montreal, Canada, in 2006. Mr. Peterson has been affiliated with USUHS since 2011. Mr. Peterson's areas of legal concentration include government ethics, human subjects research, medical ethics, healthcare law, graduate medical education, and International Law, including the Law of Armed Conflict. He is the Chair of the University's Section on Medical Jurisprudence, and holds an adjunct faculty appointment as an assistant professor in the Department of Preventive Medicine and Biostatistics.

From 1994-2014, Mr. Peterson served on active duty in the United States Air Force as a Judge Advocate. As a Judge Advocate, Mr. Peterson served in many different positions domestically and overseas, including two tours in Japan and a deployment to Baghdad, Iraq in 2009. Also of note, from 2005-2008, he was assigned to the North American Aerospace Defense Command (NORAD) and United States Northern Command (USNORTHCOM), as Chief, International Air and Space Operations Law. While on active duty, Mr. Peterson's developed legal expertise in healthcare Law, operations and international Law, and criminal prosecution. Prior to entering active duty, Mr. Peterson worked for a law firm in Bangkok, Thailand, and specialized in licensing and joint venture agreements
